

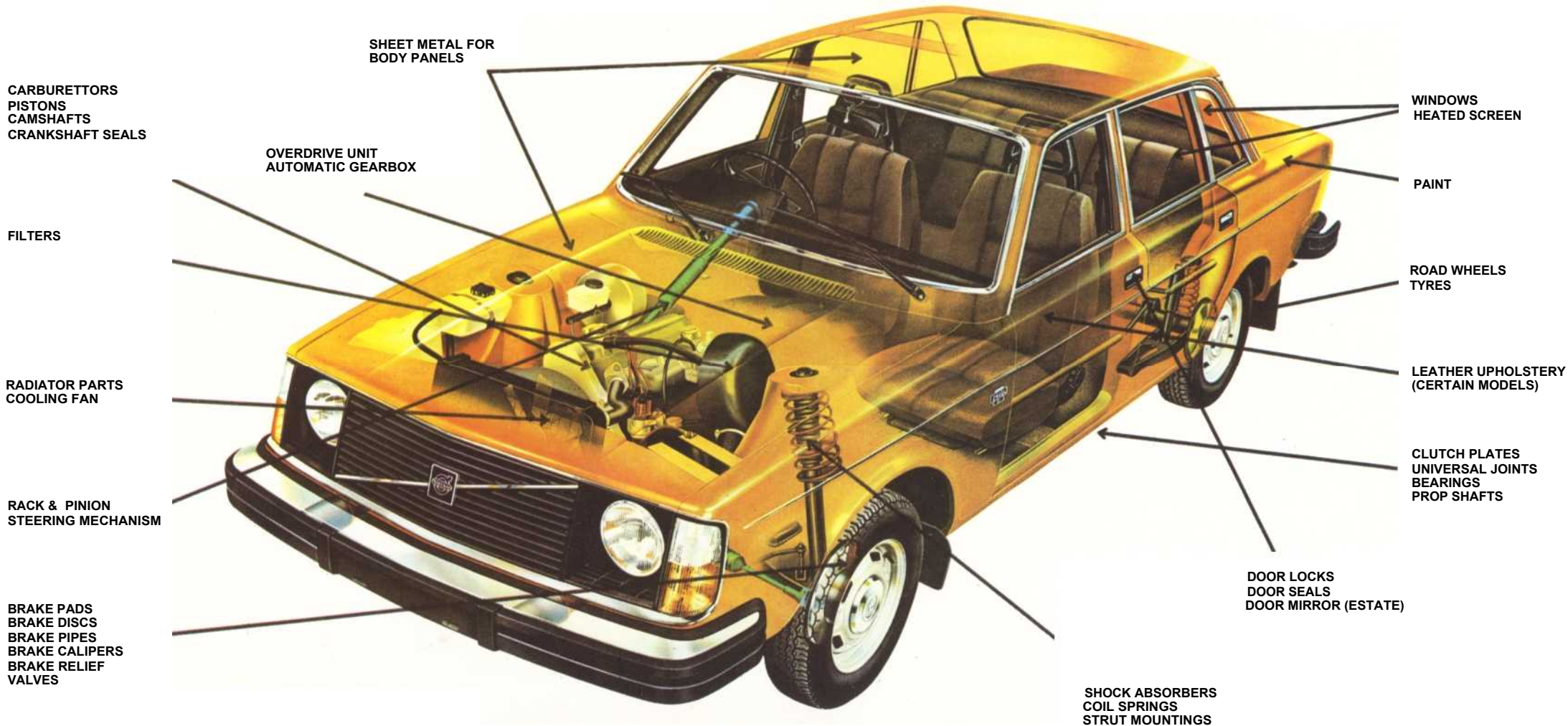
British Components used in the Manufacture of **Volvo** cars



In 1974 AB VOLVO was the largest single overseas buyer of British automotive components and parts, the total value being over £50 million. AB VOLVO has even set up a UK material-control department in Birmingham to co-ordinate the continuous flow of production materials from some 220 British factories which supply them.

Some well known companies who export large numbers of parts and components to AB VOLVO include:

Girling, Hardy Spicer, Dunlop, Michelin, Triplex, Zenith, Borg and Beck, Laycock, Armstrong, Cam Gears, Borg Warner, Britax, Rubery Owen, S.U. Carburettors, Smiths Industries, British Steel Corporation, Ferodo, Lucas, GKN.
